POLICY:

The Sponsoring Institution has formed the Chief Resident Council to provide a forum for residents/fellows to provide input and recommendation on matters affecting graduate medical education.

PURPOSE:

To provide representation from all programs that will facilitate:

- Representation for the voice of residents/fellows in decisions Mercy Health – St. Vincent Medical Center, LLC makes for graduate medical education
- Advocation on behalf of and in the interest of residents/fellows by seeking issues, relaying resident concerns, and developing solutions to those concerns
- Education through a point of communication between residents, and Mercy Health – St. Vincent Medical Center, LLC GME
- Development and implementation of plans to improve resident and fellow education, service, and life

PROCEDURE:

1. The Chief Resident Council will meet monthly.
2. The Council will Peer select a president to lead the Council. The President's term of leadership will begin on July 1 of each academic year and conclude on June 30.
3. The first 15 minutes of each Council meeting will be set aside for a resident/fellow forum. The forum portion of the meeting will be attended by residents/fellows only without the presence of the DIO, faculty members or other administrative staff present.
4. To ensure equitable representation for all programs, each program will have one vote on any issues that are brought up for an approval vote. Program's with multiple chiefs are encouraged to have all chiefs attend, but they must designate who will vote for their program. A quorum will be defined as a simple majority of programs.
5. The President of the Council will provide a brief update at the GMEC meeting.
